



# Civil Service Dinghy Championships 2010

19-20 June 2010

Organised by the Civil Service Sailing Association at Netley  
Cliff Sailing Club

## Notice of Race

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Any changes to the racing rules will be notified in the Sailing Instructions.

### 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of all monohull centreboard dinghy classes where:
  - 2.1.1 *either* at least one of either helm or crew is a CSSC Member
  - 2.1.2 *or* at least one of either helm or crew is entitled to the benefits of CSSC membership
  - 2.1.3 *or* the helm is a member of the CSSA, a member of a Club associated with one of the CSSA Divisions, or a serving member of the Royal Navy, the Army or the Royal Air Force.
- 2.2 To enter in the Junior category, both helm and crew must have been born on or after 1 January 1991.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to the address given at NoR 14 (Further Information) to arrive no later than 12 June 2010. Entry forms can be downloaded from [www.ncsc.co.uk](http://www.ncsc.co.uk).
- 2.4 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:
  - 2.4.1 that the late entry is in accordance with the restrictions on the number of boats (see 2.5 below)
  - 2.4.2 *and* that a Late Entry Fee has been paid.
- 2.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:
  - 2.5.1 up to 60 boats will be accepted into the Netley Cliff boat park
  - 2.5.2 once this number is exceeded, acceptance of further entries will be at the discretion of the Organisers, who will make reasonable endeavours to accommodate the additional numbers.

### 3 Fees

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:
  - 3.1.1 Normal entry fee: £20

- 3.1.2 Junior entry fee: £10 (see NoR 2.2)
- 3.1.3 Late Entry Fee: £30 (£15 for Junior entry).

## **4 Schedule**

- 4.1 Registration:
  - Friday 18 June 19:00 – 21:00;
  - Saturday 19 June 09:00 – 11:00;
  - and thereafter by application to the Race Organising Committee.
- 4.2 Dates of racing: Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 June.
- 4.3 Up to six (6) races will be run on the two days. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on the first day is 10:55. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on the second day is 09:55.

## **5 Measurements**

- 5.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested.

## **6 Sailing Instructions**

- 6.1 The sailing instructions (SIs) will be available on [www.ncsc.co.uk](http://www.ncsc.co.uk). Any amendments to the SIs will be published in Event SIs available at or after Registration.

## **7 Venue**

- 7.1 Racing will take place on Southampton Water between Netley Cliff Sailing Club foreshore and the shipping channel.

## **8 Courses**

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be as described in the Course Appendix to the Sailing Instructions.

## **9 Scoring**

- 9.1 RYA Average Lap Racing will be used.
- 9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 When from 4 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **10 Berthing**

- 10.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

## **11 Trophies and Prizes**

- 11.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
  - 11.1.1 The Seal Cup - to the overall winner of the Championships.

- 11.1.2 The CSSC Rose Bowl - to the first CSSC Member helm in the Championships. The crew must be a CSSC Member or one of their immediate family.
- 11.1.3 Littleton Bell - to the Club with the lowest aggregate points awarded to its best six helms in the Championship. Competitors must nominate their Club on the entry form.
- 11.1.4 The Enterprise Bowl will be awarded to the highest ranked helm in the largest class represented.
- 11.1.5 Junior Trophy - awarded to the first placed Junior helm and crew in the Championships (see NoR 2.2).
- 11.1.6 Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Championships Organising Committee.

## **12 Disclaimer of Liability**

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **13 Insurance**

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.
