Membership is open to anyone interested in sailing/canoeing/boating and we especially invite applications from people living locally. Please note that NCSC is **not** able to accommodate motor boats (i.e. boats for which an engine is their only means of propulsion). Please see below for membership rates.

Please note, NCSC is a member-run club. Five workdays are organised each winter and members are expected to attend and contribute to at least two of them. They generally take place on the third Sunday in the month (November to March) with the exception of the December workday which takes place on the second Sunday in December. They're also a great chance to meet other members.
